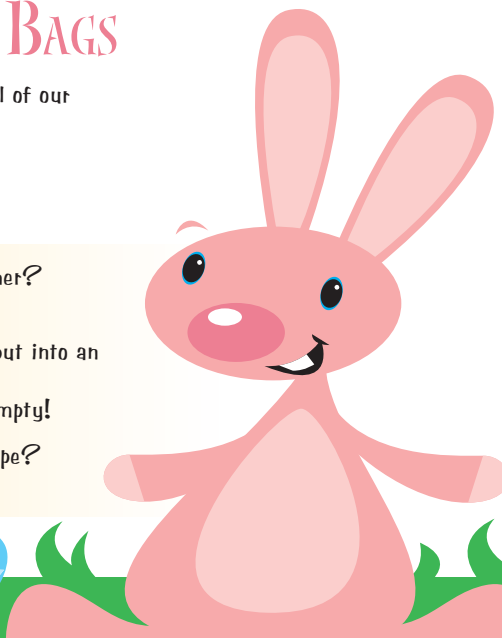

- ★ A constellation is a group of bright stars that appear to form a pattern.
- ★ The Big Dipper is usually easy to spot. But it's not really a constellation! The Big Dipper is called an asterism because it is part of a constellation (Ursa Major).
- ★ There are 88 recognized constellations.
- ★ Many of the constellations got their names from old stories and legends.
- ★ The stars in a constellation seem to be close together. But they may be far, far apart.
