Calvin J. Peterson Memorial Scholarship

Service 1 Federal Credit Union established a scholarship program in memory of former board president, Calvin J. Peterson. This program assists members who plan to pursue college studies. Scholarships are offered for those taking at least 9 credits in a semester at an accredited institution of the student's choice; the current application period is the fall of 2022.

This scholarship program is administered by the Service 1 Federal Credit Union scholarship committee. We seek to involve and assist the private sector in expanding educational opportunities and encouraging educational achievement. Awards are granted without regard to race, color, creed, religion, gender, disability, sexual orientation, or national origin.

Eligibility

Applicants to the Calvin J. Peterson Memorial Scholarship Program must be:



- A member of Service 1 Federal Credit Union or the child or grandchild of a Service 1 Federal Credit Union member
- A high school or college student who plans to enroll—or is already enrolled—in an undergraduate course of study at an accredited two- or four-year college or university

Awards

If selected as a recipient, the student will receive a \$1,000 award applied to tuition. Two scholarships will be granted for the 2022 application year. Awards are one-time only and are non-renewable.

Application

Interested/eligible students must complete the application and mail it, along with a current, complete transcript of grades, to Service 1 Federal Credit Union or email to service1fcu@gmail.com. Applications must be postmarked no later than Friday, February 4, 2022*. Grade reports are not acceptable. Online transcripts must display student name, school name, grand total and current hours earned for each course, and term in which each course was taken.

Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. Applicants are evaluated on the information supplied; therefore, answer all questions as completely as possible. All information received is considered confidential and is reviewed only by the Service 1 Federal Credit Union Scholarship Committee.

**Incomplete applications will not be considered for award selection.*

Selection of Recipients

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, demonstrated leadership and participation in school and community activities, honors, work experience, and statement of goals and aspirations.

Selection of recipients is made by the Service 1 Federal Credit Union Scholarship Committee. All applicants agree to accept the decision of the committee as final.



Applicants will be notified by March 31, 2022. Not all applicants to the program will be selected as recipients.

Payment of Scholarship

Awards will be disbursed in August 2022, prior to the start of fall classes. The award funds will be mailed directly to the college or university on behalf of the student.

Obligations

Recipients have no obligation to Service 1 Federal Credit Union. They are, however, required to supply the committee with complete transcripts when requested and to notify the committee of any changes of address, school enrollment, or other relevant information.

Revisions

Service 1 Federal Credit Union reserves the right to review the conditions and procedures of this scholarship program and to make changes at any time including termination of the program.
